

Minutes of Special Town Meeting of the Electors
Thursday, November 12, 2020

On Thursday, November 12, 2020 in the Cleveland Training Room at Lakeshore Technical College the board for the Town of Centerville held a public hearing on the proposed 2021 budget with a special meeting following directly after. In attendance were Chairman Brian Kraemer, Supervisor Jerry Vogel, Treasurer Cynthia Kraemer, Zoning Administrator Russ Tooley, and Deputy Clerk Stacy Orth. Supervisor Mike Bruckschen attended the meeting virtually. Clerk Paulette Vogt was excused. Brian Kraemer started the hearing at 6:30.

The motion was made by Russ Tooley to adopt the 2020 town tax levy to be paid in 2021 pursuant to Section 60.10 (1)(a) Wisconsin Statutes. Mike Bruckschen seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Russ Tooley made a motion to approve the total 2021 highway expenditures pursuant to Section 82.03 (2)(a) Wisconsin Statutes. (If spending exceeds \$5,000 times the number of highway miles.) Don Bogenschuetz seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Don Bogenschuetz made a motion to approve the elected board member salaries for the 2021-2022 elected term pursuant to Section 60.33 (4) Wisconsin Statutes. With a second from Jerry Vogel. Motion carried.

Brian Kraemer closed the special meeting at 6:37.
