

Minutes November Town Board Meeting  
Thursday, November 12, 2020

The monthly board meeting for the Town of Centerville took place on Thursday, November 12, 2020 in the Cleveland Training Room at Lakeshore Technical College. In attendance were Chairman Brian Kraemer, Supervisor Jerry Vogel, Treasurer Cynthia Kraemer, Zoning Administrator Russ Tooley, and Deputy Clerk Stacy Orth. Supervisor Mike Bruckschen attended the meeting virtually. Law Enforcement Officer Ian Quinn, Assessor Joe Denor, and Clerk Paulette Vogt were all excused. Brian Kraemer called the meeting to order at 6:37 following the Special Town Meeting of the Electors.

A motion to approve the agenda was made by Jerry Vogel with a second Mike Bruckschen. Motion carried.

Minutes from the October were approved as printed with a motion from Brian Kraemer and a second from Jerry Vogel. Motion carried.

Public Input on Abandonment of a portion of Lakeshore Drive: There were some questions about how the roads will be marked after closure.

A motion was made by Jerry Vogel to approve Resolution 3-2020 to close 0.13 miles of Lakeshore Drive with a second from Mike Bruckschen. Motion carried.

There was no public input on other issues.

Brian Kraemer made a motion to approve the budget with a second from Jerry Vogel. Motion carried.

Brian Kraemer made a motion to approve the contract with the Cleveland Fire Department with a second from Jerry Vogel. Motion carried.

Town officer reports: Stacy Orth read the election results from the Town of Centerville. Brian Kraemer read the assessor's report. Russ reported permits for an addition to a barn, a chicken coop, and a meditation shack were issued. He also discussed the terms for the Planning and Zoning members and stated it shouldn't be necessary to hold a meeting to try to find new members. Law enforcement stated the only issue this month was pigs that had gotten loose and needed to be caught.

Road report: The early salt order has been placed, will be delivered prior to December 1st. The sign inventory was discussed and there should be no need to order more at the moment. There are still a few spots that will need to be patched. One driveway has a culvert that needs to be cleaned out to avoid causing issues.

Recycling report: Brian stated the recycling center has changed from summer to winter hours.

The checks will be approved next month when the clerk will be back.

The next meeting is set for December 10. Mike Bruckschen made a motion to adjourn the meeting with a second from Jerry Vogel. Meeting adjourned at 6:58.
