MINUTES 2020 TOWN BOARD MEETING

Thursday, December 10, 2020

The monthly meeting of the Town of Centerville took place on Thursday, December 10, 2020 at Lakeshore Technical College, Cleveland Room, Cleveland, Wisconsin. Agendas for the meeting were posted accordingly. In attendance were Chairman Brian Kraemer, Supervisor Jerry Vogel, Clerk Paulette Vogt, Law Enforcement Officer Ian Quinn and Zoning Administrator Russ Tooley. Supervisor Mike Bruckschen, Treasurer Cynthia Kraemer, and Assessor Joe Denor were excused. Chairman Brian Kraemer called the meeting to order. The Pledge of Allegiance was said by all.

A motion was made to approve the agenda by Supervisor Jerry Vogel with a 2nd from Chairman Brian Kraemer. Motion carried.

Minutes from the November 12, 2020 Board Meeting as well as from the November 23, 2020 Special meeting were approved as emailed on a motion from Supervisor Jerry Vogel and 2nd by Chairman Brian Kraemer. Motion carried.

Public Input: There being no public input, Chairman Brian Kraemer closed public input.

Town Officer Report

Treasurer's Report: The Board reviewed the treasurer's and clerk's bank reports. Everything was in order.

Clerk Report: No report was given.

Assessor: Assessor Joe Denor was excused. No report was given.

Zoning Administrator: Zoning Administrator Russ Tooley gave a report on the total permits that had been given for the year. Chairman Brian Kraemer thanked Zoning Administrator Russ Tooley for the good job he is doing.

After a presentation of a list to the Board, Chairman Brian Kraemer made a motion to reappoint Stacy Klotz and Mike Bruckschen to the Planning and Zoning Committee. At the same time Peter Larson was reappointed to the Board of Appeals. This motion was 2nd by Supervisor Jerry Vogel. Carried.

Chairman Brian Kraemer made a motion to appoint Law Enforcement Officer Ian Quinn for another term of office and thanked him for his past service. Supervisor Jerry Vogel 2nd the same. Motion carried. Chairman Brian Kraemer then issued the Official Oath of Office to Law Enforcement Officer Ian Quinn.

Law Enforcement Officer Report: Law Enforcement Officer Quinn stated that on the 18th of November he received a call that cows were out on the road. The report stated that there was an injured cow as well. Ian Quinn reported that there was vandalism on the Centerville Bridge south of F. Spray painting was done under the south side of the bridge.

Road Report: Chairman Brian Kraemer reported that the salt the Town had ordered was delivered.

Pete's Trucking has been finishing up some patching for the year. Chairman Brian Kraemer stated that the ditch was cleaned out on South Union Road and that this should take care of the water problem now.

Chairman Brian Kraemer said the inventory on the signs will be done in spring. He stated that there are enough major signs in inventory but that he did order an additional dead end sign for Lakeshore Drive. This project is now completed. Supervisor Jerry Vogel stated he thought the turn-arounds were done nicely but they looked rather shallow. Chairman Kraemer reported that the turn arounds were laid out with input from and completed by our snow plow contractor. Most of the turnaround area was done within the existing right-of-way requiring a minimal purchasing of additional land. There were grading markers but should have posts or ends on the edge of the turn-around.

Chairman Brian Kraemer said he updated the post office about the Lakeshore Drive abandonment turn-arounds. He also reported that the 2020 Road Certification has been submitted to the state.

Recycling Report: Nothing to report.

Approval of Check Register and Checks: Chairman Brian Kraemer made a motion to approve the check register and checks, with a 2nd from Supervisor Jerry Vogel. Motion passed.

Chairman Brian Kraemer has signed up for video access to the Fall Workshops as well as the WTA Convention.

The next monthly Board meeting will be Thursday, January 14, 2021 at 6:30 at Lakeshore Technical College, Cleveland Room, Cleveland, Wisconsin.

Without further business to complete, the meeting adjourned at 6:50 p.m. with a motion made by Supervisor Jerry Vogel and a 2nd from Chairman Brian Kraemer. Motion passed.
