MINUTES APRIL 2018 TOWN BOARD MEETING

Thursday, April 12, 2018

The Town of Centerville held its monthly town meeting Thursday, April 12, 2018. Brian Kraemer, Jerry Vogel, Mike Bruckschen, Cynthia Kraemer, Val Jean Marcoe were present. Russ Tooley, Paulette Vogt, and Joe Denor were excused. The meeting was called to order at 6:30 PM. The Pledge of Allegiance was said by all present.

The agenda was approved with a motion by Jerry Vogel and it was seconded by Mike Bruckschen. The Previous month's minutes were approved by a motion made by Jerry Vogel and was seconded by Mike Bruckschen.

The board reviewed the treasurer's and clerk's bank reports. Everything was in order. The treasurer had 3 dogs that Val Jean said he would follow up on with Ian.

It was discussed to have prospective officers give report at Annual Meeting. One of the board members would read the report of Joe Denor and the other a report from the County Supervisor who would not be able to attend due to a County Board meeting the same night. Val Jean will introduce his replacement, Ian Quinn, at the Annual Meeting on April 17, 2018. Brian will contact Tom Ward for a summary report on Phragmites Grant for the Annual Meeting.

Zoning Report: Brian read report for Russ. There was a call received inquiring about a bill board near the I-43 interchange. Caller may be applying for a Conditional Use Permit for the billboard. Brian received a call from a prospective home buyer. She and her husband run a "doggy day care" and had concerns if this was permitted or if permitted with a Conditional Use Permit. Val Jean will look further into it, as will Russ and Brian.

Law Enforcement Officers Report: Val Jean mentioned he would be training Ian so Ian could be appointed at the next monthly board meeting. Val Jean is planning to be done with his position by the end of May. He gave a report of two Huskies killing a 270 lb. Alpaca. He will make a copy of all the reports for the town. He also included reports from the Alpaca owner and the resident who reported the attack.

Road Report: Road Inspection was postponed until April 21, 2018 due to expected inclement weather. Brian reviewed salt usage with the board for the submission of the 2018 salt contract. Update on Center Road bridge replacement will be presented at the Annual Meeting.

A list of the payments for the month was reviewed by the board.

Communications: Brian received flyers on Phragmites from Tom Ward to hand out at Elections, and Annual Meeting April 17.

The Annual meeting will be held Tuesday, April 18 and the next town board meeting will be held on May 10.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:05 PM. A motion was made by Jerry Vogel, and a seconded by Mike Bruckschen.
