MINUTES MARCH 2018 TOWN MEETING

The Town of Centerville held its monthly town meeting on Monday, March 12, 2018. Brian Kraemer, Jerry Vogel, Mike Bruckschen, Cindy Kraemer, Russ Tooley, Val Jean Marcoe, and Stacy Orth were present. Joe Denor and Paulette Vogt were excused. The meeting was called to order at 6:30PM. The Pledge of Allegiance was said by all present.

The agenda was approved with a motion made by Jerry Vogel and a second by Mike Bruckschen. The previous month's minutes were approved by a motion made by Jerry Vogel and a second by Mike Bruckschen, with the correction of changing the month to say February instead of December.

The annual report was approved with a motion made by Mike Bruckschen and a second from Brian Kraemer. The Annual Meeting is set to take place Tuesday, April 17. Lunch will be at 6:00 PM followed by the meeting at 6:30 PM. It was decided that a discussion should take place on whether the newsletter should be sent digitally or by mail. Also, phragmites is to be added to the agenda for the annual meeting.

Russ Tooley discussed several permits for the town and a farmland preservation rezone. There is also an upcoming Board of Appeals meeting and Planning and Zoning meeting.

Val Jean reported of two dogs at large in the last month. There was also a complaint of garbage that was dumped into a Creek and ending up in a residents yard. Ian Quinn also attended the meeting. He is set to replace Val Jean as police enforcement for the Town of Centerville.

The Town's insurance is set to renew April 1st. Jerry Vogel made a motion to approve the policy with Family Insurance Center with a second by Mike Bruckschen.

Road inspection is set to take place April 14th. The board will be meeting at Brian Kraemer's home at 8:00AM. There has been some repair made to some of the Town's signs. On September 27, 2017 a bid was awarded for bridge work. It may take another 30-90 days to get approval from the state. Will find out start date after approval from state.

The recycling center is to change to summer hours on April 1st.

The approval of checks has been tabled until next month's meeting when Paulette has returned with the books for the board to sign.

March 19th at 6:30PM there will be a meeting in the Wells Fargo room with the Kiel school district to discuss their upcoming referendum. The Chairman will meet with the President of the Village of Cleveland and the Chairman of the Town of Meeme on April 5th. They will be discussing the Village of Cleveland's proposal for financing of equipment. The next monthly meeting is set for April 12th at 6:30PM.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:10PM a motion made by Mike Bruckschen and a second Jerry Vogel.
