MINUTES October 5, 2020 Special Meeting

The Town Board of the Town of Centerville Special Meeting took place on Monday, October 5, 2020 at 5:00 P.M. at Lakeshore Technical College, Cleveland Room, Cleveland, Wisconsin. Agendas for the meeting were posted accordingly. In attendance were Chairman Brian Kraemer, Supervisor Jerry Vogel, Supervisor Mike Bruckschen, and Clerk Paulette Vogt. Town Officer Report

Chairman Brian Kraemer presented the Board with copies of Resolution 2-2020 to Discontinue of a Portion of Lakeshore Drive due to encroachment of the Lake Michigan lake bank. Supervisor Jerry Vogel noted that the date on the resolution needed to be changed along with the Clerk's misspelled name. With the corrections being made, Supervisor Jerry Vogel made a motion to adopt Resolution 2-2020. Supervisor Mike Bruckschen 2nd the same. Roll call was taken: Brian Kraemer – yes, Jerry Vogel – yes, and Mike Bruckschen – yes. Motion carried.

November 12, 2020 at 6:30 p.m. at Lakeshore Technical College, Cleveland Room, will be the public hearing date for Discontinuance of a Portion of Lakeshore Drive.

Clerk Paulette Vogt will file the Lis pendens with the County Register of Deeds. The Notice of Board Hearing on the Resolution will be posted in 3 places, sent certified with affidavits that proper notice was served, and also sent to the DNR and the County Land Conservation Committee.

Without further business to complete, the meeting adjourned at 5:25 p.m. with a motion made by Supervisor Mike Bruckschen and a 2nd from Supervisor Jerry Vogel. Motion passed.
