MINUTES 2019 OF SPECIAL TOWN MEETING OF THE ELECTORS OF THE TOWN OF CENTERVILLE

The Town Board of the Town of Centerville held a Special Town Meeting Thursday, November 8, 2018 following the 2019 Proposed Budget Hearing at Lakeshore Technical College, Cleveland. Hearing notices were published as a class 2 notice in the Herald Times Reporter and posted in three places 15 days prior, including posting on the website. Present were Brian Kraemer, Cindy Kraemer, Mike Bruckschen, Ian Quinn, Russ Tooley, Paulette Vogt and Joe Denor. There were no other residents of the town present.

The Pledge of Allegiance was said by all present.

Chairman Kraemer called the hearing to order at 6:40 P.M. After some discussion, Supervisor Vogel made a motion to approve the 2018 tax levy payable in 2019 of \$256,048.00. Supervisor Bruckschen 2nd said motion. A show of hands showed 3 yes and no nay. Motion Carried.

A motion was then made by Supervisor Vogel to approve the highway expenditures in the amount of \$243,713.00 with the authorization for the board to borrow up to an additional \$50,000 in case of extraordinary weather conditions or other road emergencies that may arise. Supervisor Bruckschen 2nd said motion. Motion Carried.

After some discussion of the salaries and that there has not been a change in the elected salaries since 2012, Russ Tooley made a motion to approve the elected Town Board salaries for the next term pursuant to Sec. 60.32(4) Wis Stats. by 4%. Supervisor Vogel 2nd the same. Motion carried.
