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MINUTES 2019 SPECIAL TOWN MEETING/ORDINANCE HEARING OF THE ELECTORS

OF THE TOWN OF CENTERVILLE

Thursday, November 14, 2019

The Town Board of the Town of Centerville held a special Town Meeting on Thursday, November 14, 2019 following the 2020 Proposed Budget Hearing at Lakeshore Technical College in Cleveland. Hearing notices were published in the Herald Times Reporter and posted in three places 15 days prior, including posting on the website. Present were Chairman Brian Kraemer, Supervisor Mike Bruckschen, Clerk Paulette Vogt, Treasurer Cynthia Kraemer, Zoning Administrator Russ Tooley, and Law Enforcement Officer Ian Quinn. There were no other residents of the Town present. Chairman Brian Kraemer called the meeting to order at 6:45 p.m.

The Pledge Allegiance was said by all present.

After some discussion Zoning Administrator Russell Tooley made a motion to approve the 2019 tax levy payable in 2020 of \$422,009.00. Treasurer Cynthia Kraemer 2nd said motion. Motion Carried.

A motion was made by Zoning Administrator Russ Tooley and 2nd by Treasurer Cynthia Kraemer to approve the highway expenditures with the authorization for the Board to borrow up to an additional \$50,000 in case of extraordinary weather conditions or other road emergencies that may arise. Motion carried.

Ordinance 1-2019. After some discussion, the Board carefully reviewed the changes made to the Ordinance to Amend Town of Centerville's General Code of Ordinances in Chapter 4 – Licensing and Permits, and Chapter 9 – Zoning and Land Use. These changes will be brought up at the next Town Board Meeting for approval.

There was no public comment. Supervisor Michael Bruckschen made a motion to adjourn. Treasurer Cynthia Kraemer 2nd the same. Motion Carried. Hearing closed at 6:55 p.m.
